SYNC 365

Independent Study

Class Description -

SYNC 365 is designed to teach you how to find REAL solutions to your REAL problems. SYNC 365 will teach you how to DAILY go through your Bible, take notes on the scripture read, and begin real prayer times. Instead of having to rely only on what “others” say about the Bible, SYNC 365 will allow you to learn for yourself exactly what the Bible says. By the end of the course you will have read the entire Bible through one complete time and taken notes and prayed daily. If you take and complete this course you will be well on your way to finding God's answers to your EVERY PROBLEM!

Benefits of taking the class –

This class will literally change your life. It will enable you to SYNC what the word of God says to every area of your life. No longer will your life be made up of different compartments (school, church, home, friends, teams) instead your life will transform to one huge device that controls everything – Jesus Christ. No other devices are needed. As you begin to SYNC your life to Christ, big changes will happen. You will find answers to life's many questions and you will have learned the real skills necessary to succeed in life!

Test –

All tests will be pop test. God will give you the test as HE thinks you are ready. However, your grade is only between you and God. Tests will be comprised of things the Bible is teaching you through your daily reading and prayer time. The good news is that each test will be “open book” – you can go back to your Bible at any time for the answer. In addition God will send a friend to help you along the way and give you answers - the Holy Spirit. By learning how to use both tools provided by God, tests will not be so scary. In fact you'll eventually learn to look forward to them because they help you see your progress.

Class Pace –

Because it's a home study, you will set your own pace. SYNC 365 gives you a guide line to follow. However, if it's overwhelming, you're free to do half the work. It will take you longer to make it through the course, but the idea here is to really learn, not just to fly through and not comprehend. Unlike your Algebra class, you will actually use this when you grow up! You need to learn it well!

Cliff Note Version

So exactly what do I do?

Three Simple Steps:

1. Read the assigned Bible text.
2. Take notes like in history class on the days reading.
3. Pray.

Breakdown:

1. Read the assigned Bible text.

By reading each day scripture you will read the entire Bible through THIS year!

2. Take notes like I do in History class.

You've learned how to take notes in school. We're going to take the same skill set you use every day in school and apply it to the Bible. *No one will check your notes.* Whether you use bullet points, summaries, or paragraphs - it won't matter. This is for your reference only. The way to "really learn" something is to write it down – in your own words. By taking notes or writing a brief summary of everything you read, overtime you will naturally begin applying what you learn. Application of the Bible will transform your life!

3. Pray.

Prayer is communication. You already communicate via text, email, facebook or the phone most everyday with your friends. How about spending some time communicating with the GOD OF THE UNIVERSE that literally has your EVERY ANSWER?! Even better, HE IS NEVER TOO BUSY to take your call.

There are many ways to pray. With each day's scripture there is a page for you to write down your prayers if you so choose. Use this space to record all your concern and problems. As you bring things before God, watch as HE begins to answer. As God answers your prayers go back and record the answer beside the request. This can be a huge tool to help you stay focused and "synced" with God, especially when things get tough.

ADVANCED COURSE (optional)

An advanced course is offered for those students who would like an extra challenge. The Advanced Level SYNC 365 consists of the same commitment of the original plan with the addition of scripture to commit to memory over the next 365 days. Many of the passages are long and may take you a while to memorize. Write them on index cards and review them daily. You'll have them down in no time!

Here's a good idea - challenge your parents to do this with you! Make it a contest. See if you can get your parents to attach a prize to the end. Most likely you'll beat your parents "hands down!" Memorizing while you're young is much easier than waiting until you're old and saggy!

2. TAKE Chapter Notes:

Genesis 1 -

- God created the heavens and earth
- Order of creation - 1. Day and Night; 2. Sky and water; 3. Land and seas, plants and trees; 4. Seasons, days, years - the sun and the moon; 5. Fish, birds; 6. Animals on land and MAN;

Genesis 2 -

- God rested on the 7th day and called it Holy
- Man placed over all the creatures of the earth
- There was no rain - just a mist going up from the earth - cool!
- Man lived in the garden Eden - in the East.
- Tree of life was in the midst of the garden and the tree of knowledge of good and evil. Doesn't say what fruit.
- River flowed out of Eden - and divided and became four rivers - Rivers named - Pishon, Gihon, Tigris and Euphrates - (I know where Tigris and Euphrates are even today!)
- Man could eat of every tree but the tree of knowledge of good and evil - or die.
- Man named all the animals
- Adam (v. 20 - first time called a name) put to sleep and took one of his ribs and made a woman - because it wasn't good that Adam was alone.
- They were naked and were not ashamed

3. PRAY

**Use the guideline below to help you concentrate and really talk to GOD!
Add in extra notebook paper as needed.**

FIRST - Take a minute and really think about the fact that you are walking into God's throne room to talk to HIM! He's a big GOD but He's also your father! You are allowed to go directly to HIM and talk freely.

THANK GOD - Thank God for ALL!

CONFESS & REPENT- Ask God to show you the areas where you are letting HIM down and not really following HIM. As things come to your mind, write them down. Ask forgiveness.

TELL & ASK - Take a few minutes and tell God all of your concerns and problems. Tell HIM if something is bothering you. ASK him to help you. There is NOTHING you can hide from GOD so tell HIM EVERYTHING! HE cares about the big and small stuff! Talk to God as you would your best friend!

Genesis 3

- Eve didn't question that a snake was talking to her – what does that mean? Talking animals?
- Satan began his attack by asking her questions
- Satan cast doubt
- Eve said God said not to touch the fruit - God never said that.
- Eve thought it LOOKED good. How often does that get me into trouble?!
- Why did Adam eat? We don't see him protesting at all?
- They instantly place blame and we don't hear them say they are sorry or ask for forgiveness.
- Punishments: Snake -cast to the ground on his belly forever; Eve – pain in child birth and strife with her husband; Adam – now going to have to toil and “work” the land, his job just got really hard. ALL – were cast out of the garden!
- v. 20 shows the first pictures of death – the animals were taken and killed for their skins for Adam and Eve.

Genesis 4 -

- Cain was Adam and Eve's 1st child - Abel was 2nd
- Cain worked the land and Abel the animals.
- Cain's offering (vegetables, fruit, whatever) was rejected and Abel's offering (first born of his flock) accepted.
- It does not say why Cain's offering was rejected but because of what God says next – it might be good to assume that Cain's offering was not accepted because Cain's heart was wrong.
- God warned Cain not to give in to his flesh – “sin is crouching at the door – its desire is for you but you must rule over it”. God warned him not to give in to his desires – Hate? Envy? Jealousy?
- Cain gives into his passions and kills Abel – v. 8 – sounded like it started as a verbal argument and ended up in Abel's death. It's so easy for our tempers to get out of control!
- Cain doesn't come clean before God. In fact v.9 Cain flat out lies to God and says he doesn't know where Abel is.
- God's punishment to Cain – sounds like Cain is no longer going to be able to be a farmer – that the ground “wouldn't yield its strength” – instead he's wander.
- Cain never asks forgiveness. Instead we see Cain upset about his punishment, not begging forgiveness for what he did.

Genesis 5 - **You're turn again - just like last time!**

Summary: I'm pretty sure that God expects me to obey him based off of the above chapters. Obedience is a big deal to God. Unlike my parents sometimes, HE really does mean what HE says!
